BEFORE THE DAY

Type your six locations into the table below. They fill in everywhere else automatically — every station on this guide *and* every clue card at the back. Do that first, then print. Each station tells you what to set up there.

What to print: this page is yours — print it once. Pages 2–4 are the teacher guide, one per teacher. Pages 5–9 are the clue cards, one set per group. Running several groups at once? Leave a small stack at each station.

STATION	WHAT IT NEEDS TO BE	YOUR LOCATION
Station 0 Home Base	A classroom or large-group room where every group starts.	
Station 1 Play Area	A playground, gym, or wherever your kids play freely.	
Station 2 Target Game	An aiming game — cornhole, darts, archery, buckets and balls. Out of sight of Station 1.	
Station 3 The Cross	A wooden cross you can hammer a nail into. Two boards will do.	
Station 4 Open Space	A large open area with room to run an active game.	
Station 5 Response Room	A classroom quiet enough to hold their attention.	

WHAT TO GATHER

Your target game • a wooden cross and one long nail • quarter-sheet paper strips and pencils, one per student • Good News Response Cards, one per student • the cut-out clue cards, plus tape or something to weight them down.

1 Corinthians 15:1-4

"Let me now remind you, dear brothers and sisters, of the Good News I preached to you before... It is this Good News that saves you... Christ died for our sins, just as the Scriptures said. He was buried, and he was raised from the dead on the third day, just as the Scriptures said."

_____ (Station 3), find the thing that Jesus died on.

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SET UP

Your target game, with **Clue 2** hidden on it — under a cornhole board, behind the target, inside a bucket.

DO

Let everyone take a turn at the target. We sometimes "miss the mark."

SAY

"Even though I disobey God (that's called sin), he made a way for me to be forgiven."

HUNT

Find **Clue 2** and have a student read it aloud.

Go to _____ where you can run and play

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SET UP

 The cross with one long nail hammered partway in. Paper strips and pencils beside it. **Clue 3** weighted down nearby.

DO

 Each student writes something they do that is a sin on a paper strip, then pushes it onto the nail.

SAY

"He sent his Son Jesus to earth to live a perfect life, die on the cross for my sins, and rise again because he has power over sin and death."

HUNT

 Once everyone has had a turn, find **Clue 3** and have a student read it aloud.

The Wide-Open Space

Clue 4

Romans 10:9-10
 "If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by openly declaring your faith that you are saved."

Go to _____ (Station 5)

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SET UP

 Nothing for the game. **Clue 4** weighted down at the edge of the space.

SAY

"I can repent of my sins and put God in charge of my life so I can become more like Jesus."

PLAY

"What Time Is It, Mr. Wolf?"

The **Wolf** stands at the end of the play area with their back turned. The kids ask, "What's the time, Mr. Wolf?" The wolf answers with a time ("3 o'clock!") and the kids take that many steps forward. When the wolf turns around and shouts "Dinner time!" everyone runs back to safety before being tagged.

SAY

"When we repent, we turn around and go the opposite direction. We stop doing the wrong thing and turn and start doing the correct thing."

HUNT

 After the game, find **Clue 4** and have a student read it aloud.

STATION 5

The Response Room

LOCATION _____

AT THIS STATION

No clue card here — this is the last stop.

SET UP

Good News Response Cards in the room, one per student.

SAY

“God is ready to give me eternal life and save me right now.”

TELL

Tell a short, couple of minute, story of when you, yourself, confessed Jesus as Lord of your life.

SAY

“I prayed a prayer like this. When you are ready, this is how you can pray.”

PRAY

“Jesus, I’m so happy that you love me and you want me to live with you forever. I confess to you that I disobey you. I sin by doing things that I know are wrong. But I believe that you sent your Son Jesus to earth to die for my sins and that he rose from the grave 3 days later to prove that he has power over sin and death. I repent of my sins and ask that you take charge of my life. I want to follow you and become more like you. I want you to save me, forgive me of my sins and make me right with you. Amen.”

DO

Give each student a **Good News Response Card** to take home.
